Starting Positions: Sit in your own space on the floor

Learning Intentions:

To know about...

- The story of Little Red Riding Hood
- The different characters and places in Little Red Riding Hood

Synopsis:

- Dad asks you to make some cupcakes for Granny because she's ill.
- You bake the cupcakes, put them in your basket and put on your red coat.
- You wander through the forest and see the plants, animals and a little bird.
- You meet a wolf! He asks where you're going. You tell him Granny's house.
- As the wolf, you creep through the forest to Granny's house.
- As Red, you meet the Woodcutter who asks where you're going.
- At Granny's house, "Granny" invites you in. You sit by her bed.
- It's not Granny at all – it's the wolf!
- As the woodcutter, you come in with your axe – and scare off the wolf.
- You find Granny in the cupboard.
- Dad turns up. You say you'll tell him what happened over tea and your cupcakes.

Characters:

- **Dad**
- **Wolf**
- **Granny**
- **Woodcutter**

Locations:

- **At home**
- **The forest**
- **Granny's house**

Glossary:

- **Woodcutter** – someone who chops down trees for firewood

Discussion:

Story & Factual

- Why were we making cupcakes for Granny?
- What things did we put in our cupcakes?
- What did we put on before we went outside?
- What did we see in the forest? (animals, plants, trees?)
- Who did we meet in the forest?
- What three things did we say to Granny? (“What big... “)
- What did the woodcutter do when she came in?
- How did we decide to celebrate at the end?

PSHE and feelings

- What should you do when someone’s not feeling well?
- Which moments did you find most scary?
- Should you talk to strangers? If they ask where you’re going should you tell them?
- Who was your favourite character? Red, the wolf or the woodcutter?
- Would you make different choices from Red? What would you do differently?
