

Neil Armstrong: Writing Tasks

Letter to NASA

Write a letter from Neil to NASA, explaining why you are the right person to go to the Moon.

You might include...

- What you're good at
- What you've done in your life so far
- What your dreams are

Newspaper report

Write a report for a newspaper, announcing that Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin are the first men to land on the moon.

You might include...

- How the Eagle landed on the moon.
- Neil's famous words, "This is one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind"
- What Neil and Buzz did on the moon

Remember...

- To write a headline at the top

Eagle logbook

A 'logbook' is like a diary for a ship, aeroplane - or a spacecraft! Write an entry by Buzz in the logbook of the Eagle. It might begin like a diary: "Today on the Eagle we..."

You might include...

- How Neil fixed the broken radio.
- The food you eat & the exercises you do
- What it's like with no gravity

Remember...

- The date and place at the top (e.g. The Eagle, 9th July, 1969)

Mission To Mars

Write a story about landing on Mars. Pretend it's the year 2060.

You might include...

- What your futuristic spaceship is like
- What Mars is like (remember it's red)
- What do you find on Mars?

Remember...

- To describe Mars not just say what happened
